RE: COUNCIL'S INTERNSHIP QUALIFYING EXAMS –MEDICAL AND DENTAL

Reference is made to the above.

Pursuant to Section 11 (1)(a) of the Medical Practitioners and Dentists Act (CAP 253) the Board has the mandate to ensure that a holder of a medical or dental degree has engaged in training employment (internship) in a resident medical capacity in one or more institution approved by the Board, for such period, being not less than one year.

In addition to the above, Rule 18 of the Medical Practitioners and Dentists (Training Assessment and Registration) Rules states that:

Any person who has qualified outside Kenya shall be required to engage in internship and, unless exempted under rule 23, shall be required to pass an internship qualifying examination (in this Part referred to as “the examination”), which may be written or oral or both, recognized and approved by the Board and which is of equivalent standard to the qualifying examinations in medicine or dentistry by the universities in Kenya approved by the Board.

In view of the above, you are hereby informed that the Board's Internship Qualifying Exams – Medical is scheduled to take place on **Monday 14th September, 2020 –Wednesday 16th September, 2020**. The timetable hereunder: -

(both medical & dental candidates)

15th – 16th September, 2020
Kenya Medical Training College, Nairobi Campus (Clinical exam- conducted in OSCE Model. (Objective, Structured, Clinical exam) for Medical Candidates

15th-16th September, 2020
Kenyatta National Hospital (KNH)- Dental Unit. All areas of clinical dentistry will be examined for Dental Candidates.

REQUIREMENTS TO ALL CANDIDATES

1. Student must wear a mask.
2. Student must carry a sanitizer.
3. Student must carry an electronic device- Laptop, tablet, that has capability and can sustain battery charge for at least 3 hours.
4. The candidates will be required to be present at the venue of the examination at the venue of the examination at 7am for registration.
5. Candidates are required to bring with them: Patella hammer, BP Machine, Stethoscope and tape measure during the clinical exam.
