REMINDER OF TRANSITION TO ONLINE ATTESTATION OF MEDICAL CERTIFICATE

The Kenya Medical Practitioners and Dentists reminds all stakeholders that the transition from the manual medical certificate attestation process to the fully online attestation system is currently underway.

The transition period will conclude on **31st July 2026**, with **full implementation taking effect on 3rd August 2026**. From this date, **all medical certificate attestations will be processed exclusively through the online platform**, and the manual attestation process will no longer be available.

The Council wishes to clarify that medical certificate attestation is **NOT** required for all medical certificates, reports or clinical notes. Attestation is only applicable where verification by the Council is required as part of an application or process before another institution, employer, authority or other requesting body.

The online attestation service is available through the Practitioner Portal and can only be accessed by licensed medical practitioners who are in good standing with the Council.

The Council appreciates the continued cooperation and support of all stakeholders and remains available to provide guidance.

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
